Thursday's luncheon attendees will hear from **Doc Hendley**, who calls himself proof that anyone, even a "tattooed keg-tapper", can cure what ails the world. He is an individual who has truly made a difference. Tens of thousands of people around the world now have clean

drinking water because an idea popped into the head of this bartender/musician. Hendley realized that using his ability to tend bar and create relationships with people, he might be able to help tackle the clean water crisis. At the bars where he worked, he started raising money to fight this water epidemic the best way he knew how, by pouring wine and playing music.

Hendley has taken personal risks to do the hard work of providing water and clean water education in far flung locations around the globe. He worked in dozens of refugee camps installing water systems for victims of Darfur's government supported genocide. Often inside the United Nations' dangerous "no-go" zones, he distributed water or chlorine tablets to people with only plastic sheeting for shelter. Hendley was named one of the Top 10 CNN Heroes for 2009 (chosen from over 9,000 applicants by a panel of judges including Gen. Colin Powell, Whoopi Goldberg, Ted Turner and Sir Elton John).

Today Hendley's Wine to Water organization aims to help the 1.1 billion people worldwide who lack access to clean water. By using wine events to raise money and awareness about the lack of clean drinking water in the developing world, Hendley has harnessed a powerful social force and multiplied the generosity of many.



At Friday's breakfast, you will have the opportunity to hear former Senate Pro Tem **Darrell Steinberg** one of the most respected political leaders in California. For over two decades, Steinberg has been involved in local and state government. He has served on the Sacramento City Council, in the California State

Assembly and as Senate Pro Tem from 2008 to 2014. Over the course of his legislative tenure, Steinberg forged difficult agreements to usher the state from a \$42 billion deficit to a surplus budget, implement groundbreaking mental healthcare legislation, strengthen the state's foster care system, improve K-12 education standards, reform the statewide ballot initiative, and make historic investments in California's water and transportation infrastructure. Steinberg currently represents the office of Greenberg Traurig and is the chair of the firm's California Government Law & Policy Practice





Keenan – Driving Successful JPA Programs

In the 1980s, when schools could not obtain the coverage they needed from the conventional insurance market, Keenan helped drive the pioneering innovation of creating JPAs for risk sharing and pooled purchasing of coverage by public agencies. We believe strongly in the JPA model for helping schools, cities, counties and other public entities to expand their resources and optimize dollars toward risk management success.

This year, three of the major JPAs that Keenan manages, Northern California ReLiEF (NCR), Southern California ReLiEF (SCR) and the State Wide Association of Community Colleges (SWACC) will be celebrating their 30th anniversaries serving California public educational institutions.
